

Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

WHEREAS, Rocky Mountain Holdings, LLC, d/b/a Air Methods LLC (hereinafter sometimes “Air Methods”), a licensed rotary-wing advanced life support service provider in the State of Florida, has requested a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) in order to provide air ambulance transport services to the citizens and visitors of Levy County for emergency and critical patients; and

WHEREAS, Air Methods indicates that it desires not to conflict with the current level of out-of-hospital emergency care being provided by Levy County; and

WHEREAS, need has been demonstrated for Air Methods to operate in Levy County to provide essential emergency medical air ambulance transport services to the citizens and visitors of Levy County; and

WHEREAS, this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity does not authorize or imply authorization for any other type of transport service or services except the air ambulance transport services as stated herein. Any new or additional types of transport service or services will require a separate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity; and

WHEREAS, Air Methods has indicated that it currently complies and will maintain compliance with the requirements of the Emergency Medical Services Act (Chapter 401, Florida Statutes) and rules (Chapters 64J-1 and 64J-2, Florida Administrative Code); and

WHEREAS, in issuing this Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the recommendations of the municipalities within its jurisdiction.

THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 401.25(2)(d), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners Levy County hereby issues a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Rocky Mountain Holdings, LLC, d/b/a Air Methods LLC, for air ambulance transport services in Levy County.

This certificate shall remain in force and effect for the period ending January 27, 2028. This Certificate may be suspended by the Director of the Levy County Department of Public Safety and revoked by the Levy County Board of County Commissioners for failure by Air Methods to comply with applicable requirements of federal, state or local laws, statutes, rules or regulations.
