

Hello,

My name is Ethan I'm from the health department and was getting back to you regarding the property you were inquiring about. I don't see any immediate issues based on what I see in terms of location. The soil conditions onsite could change things such as whether the system needs to be above ground or not and the size of the system. Being near long pond I would imagine the water table is relatively high and could result in the system being above ground as a mound. Other then that I don't see any reason why a septic system can't be installed on this lot so long as it meets all setback requirements in 62-2 FAC. We will need to do a site evaluations to determine specifics on the system.
