The Public Works Committee of the Lincoln Parish Police Jury met in the Police Jury Meeting Room, 100 West Texas Avenue, Ruston, Louisiana, Tuesday, February 11, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. Present were: Greg Williams, Chair, Dan Lord, T.J Cranford, Milton Melton, and Diane Richards.

Chair Greg Williams called the meeting to order and Karen Ludley delivered the Invocation.

Dan Lord offered a motion, seconded by Milton Melton, to approve the Agenda. The motion carried with the following votes:

Cranford offered a motion, seconded by Milton Melton, to recommend approving final plat for Oak Tree Road, Unit 1 Subdivision with contingencies. The motion carried with the following votes:
