The Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Committee of the Lincoln Parish Police Jury met in the Police Jury Meeting Room, 100 West Texas Avenue, Tuesday, December 10, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. Present were: Dan Lord, Chair, Karen Ludley, Milton Melton, and Annette Straughter.

ABSENT: TJ Cranford

Chair Dan Lord called the meeting to order and delivered the Invocation.

Annette Straughter offered a motion, seconded by Dan Lord, to approve the agenda. The motion carried with the following votes:

YEAS: Ludley, Lord, Melton, and Straughter

Chairman Lord called for Public Comments on Agenda Items. There were none.

The first item on the Agenda was to discuss and take action if necessary, adjustments in park fees. Treasurer Michael Sutton reported that with pending reductions in revenues provided from other sources the park needed to make adjustments to various fees in order to maintain self-sustainability and provide for future improvements. Mr. Sutton proposed the following changes:

- Land Use Fee from \$3.00 to \$5.00 per person with a maximum \$20.00 per standard vehicle
- Standard RV site from \$35.00 to \$50.00 per night
- Premium RV site from \$40.00 to \$55.00 per night
- Deluxe RV site from \$45.00 to \$65.00 per night

Chairman Lord proposed that the daily archery range fee also be increased from \$8.00 to \$10.00. Following further discussion, Annette Straughter offered a motion, seconded by Karen Ludley, to make adjustment to the fees as proposed. The motion passed with the following votes:

YEAS: Ludley, Lord, Melton, and Straughter

Chair Lord called for Public Comments. There were none.

There being no other business to come before the Committee, Annette Straughter offered a motion, seconded by Milton Melton, to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
