

Resolution

Whereas, on July 1, 2015, a new six year driver's license was implemented;

And, Whereas, as a result of this action, the State of Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of Motor Vehicles, is projecting a decrease in the number of customers needing to visit their local field office;

And, Whereas, this reduction in the number of customers will have a direct negative financial impact on the amount of service fees collected and remitted to the Lincoln Parish Police Jury;

And, Whereas, the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the Lincoln Parish Police Jury have entered into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement whereby said service fees will be used to offset costs incurred by the Police Jury for housing the local Motor Vehicle Office;

And, Whereas, in an effort to offset this decrease in revenue, Act 765 of the 2014 Legislative Session was amended to allow an increase in the service fee collected on behalf of the Lincoln Parish Police Jury, not to exceed four dollars and fifty cents,

Now, Therefore, BE It Resolved, that the Lincoln Parish Police Jury authorizes the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections, Office of Motor Vehicles, to immediately begin the collection of the maximum authorized service fee of four dollars and fifty cents.
