

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE LINCOLN PARISH POLICE JURY FORMALLY ADOPTING THE LINCOLN PARISH LONG-RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Parish Police Jury recognizes the importance of a safe, efficient, and well-maintained transportation network for the economic development and quality of life of its residents; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Jury authorized a comprehensive review of its existing transportation infrastructure and future needs, resulting in the development of the "Lincoln Parish Long-Range Transportation Plan" prepared in cooperation with Hunt, Guillot, and Associates, LLC and the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development; and,

WHEREAS, the comprehensive plan development process included robust public engagement to identify top-priority needs, including roadway maintenance, safety improvements, traffic congestion management, and bicycle/pedestrian pathways; and,

WHEREAS, the final Long-Range Transportation Plan identifies prioritized projects intended to guide the parish's infrastructure investments over the next 20 years; and

WHEREAS, adoption of this plan is necessary to secure federal and state funding from agencies that require projects to be part of a formally adopted plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Lincoln, State of Louisiana, that:

1. Adoption: The Lincoln Parish Long-Range Transportation Plan, dated January 2026, is hereby formally adopted as the official long-range transportation guide for Lincoln Parish.
2. Implementation: The Police Jury authorizes the Parish Administrator and designated staff to utilize this plan for prioritizing infrastructure projects and submitting applications for federal and state funding.
3. Review: The Plan shall be reviewed periodically to ensure its continued relevance to the transportation needs of the parish.
