RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, a right-of-way servitude for a parish maintained road known as <u>Lester</u> Road was dedicated for public use; and,

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statute 48:701 provides, in part, that parish governing authorities of the state may revoke and set aside the dedication of all roads, streets, and alleyways laid out and dedicated to public use within their respective limits, when the roads, streets, and alleyways have been abandoned or are no longer needed for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Police Jury of Lincoln Parish has properly advertised in the Official Journal and notified necessary property owners of their intention to abandon <u>Lester Road</u>.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Police Jury of Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, convened in regular session this 10th day of June, 2025, that in accordance with the terms and provisions of LRS. 48:701, the dedication of the right-of-way servitude of <u>Lester Road</u> is hereby revoked and set aside and shall revert to the present owner or owners of land contiguous thereto.
