A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST PARK, WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1836 TO ALLOW FOR APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF ALTERNATES ON THE CLIMATE ACTION COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2022, Resolution 1836 was passed creating the Climate Action Committee; and

WHEREAS, some of the City's commissions, boards and committees have been unable at times to seat a quorum of members for a meeting, which is necessary for the body to meet and discuss City business; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council finds that it is in the City's best interest to have the option of appointing and confirming two alternate members on commissions, boards and committees help meet quorum requirements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lake Forest Park, as follows:

Section 1. RESOLUTION 1836 AMENDED. Pursuant to LFPMC 2.22.020(C), the Mayor and City Council jointly create the Climate Action Committee by passage of Resolution 1836. Resolution 1836 is hereby amended to allow for up to two alternate members to be appointed and confirmed that may be called upon to substitute for absent members, and who will have the same powers and duties as a member for that meeting. All other sections and provisions in Resolution 1836 remain the same.
