HONORING AND THANKING JON LEBO LAKE FOREST PARK COUNCILMEMBER

WHEREAS, Jon Lebo, a lifelong member of the Lake Forest Park community, grew up attending Lake Forest Park Elementary, Kellogg Middle School, and graduated from Shorecrest High School, later returning to raise his family in Lake Forest Park; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Lebo was elected to the Lake Forest Park City Council in 2022, bringing with him valuable professional experience, civic engagement, and a long-standing dedication to the City; and

WHEREAS, prior to his election to the Council, Jon served on the Lake Forest Park Planning Commission from 2013 to 2020, providing long-term guidance on land use policy, community development planning, and thoughtful stewardship of the City's vision; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure, Councilmember Lebo served as Council Liaison to the Planning Commission, Chair of the Council Budget and Finance Committee, and a member of the SCA Public Issues Committee, providing thoughtful regional representation; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Lebo earned Bachelor of Arts degrees in Architectural Studies and Building Construction from the University of Washington, and is a licensed architect with a distinguished professional career in capital project development; and

WHEREAS, he retired as a Director of Capital Projects at the University of Washington after 29 years of service, managing teaching, laboratory, residential, historic, and recreational facility projects, demonstrating extensive leadership in major public construction initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Lebo currently serves as Deputy Executive Project Director at Sound Transit, contributing to the \$3.7 billion East Link Extension light rail project, a major regional transportation investment serving the greater Puget Sound; and

WHEREAS, Jon lives in Lake Forest Park with his wife, a substitute teacher in the Shoreline School District, and their three sons, each of whom graduated from Shorecrest High School, continuing the family's long tradition of engagement in local education and community life.
