Subject: Appointment to the Loganville Planning Commission

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the City Council review the submitted applications and appoint three commissioners at the April 9, 2026 Council meeting.

Two current commissioners Toyin Olaoluwa and Joshua Wauter have terms expiring. The third seat is vacant following Keith Colquitt's resignation after his election to the City Council.

Council action is needed to fill all three seats to ensure the Planning Commission maintains full membership and continuity in reviewing zoning, land-use, and development matters.

FISCAL IMPLICATION: Planning Commission members receive \$25 per month. This stipend is a budgeted expense and does not require additional appropriation.

BACKGROUND: The Loganville Planning Commission plays a key advisory role in reviewing rezoning requests, variance applications, and land-use matters before they advance to the City Council.

Sec. 119-59. - Establishment of planning commission

(a) *Membership.* A planning commission is hereby established which shall consist of seven members that are appointed by majority vote of council for terms of four years. Four members shall serve for a term expiring at the April planning commission meeting in the year 2022. Successors to those four members, who shall be appointed at the first council meeting in April 2022, shall serve the four-year term, expiring at the April planning commission meeting in the year of 2026. Such successors thereafter of these positions shall also serve four-year terms. Three members shall serve for a term expiring at the April planning commission meeting in the year 2024. Successors to those three members, who shall be appointed at the first council meeting in April 2028, shall serve a four-year term.
