**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DECERTIFICATION OF TAX INCREMENT  
FINANCING DISTRICT NO. 1-6**

**WHEREAS**, the Economic Development Authority of the City of Long Lake, Minnesota (the "Authority") has heretofore established the Redevelopment Project No. 1 (the "Redevelopment Project") in the City of Long Lake, Minnesota (the "City"); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2001 the City and the Authority established Tax Increment Financing District No. 1-6, a redevelopment district, ("District No. 1-6") within the Redevelopment Project; and

**WHEREAS**, as of the date hereof obligations to which tax increment from District No. 1-6 have been pledged have been paid in full or defeased and all other costs of the Redevelopment Project have been paid; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires by this Resolution to cause the decertification of District No. 1-6, after which all property taxes generated by property within District No. 1-6 will be distributed in the same manner as all other property taxes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Long Lake, Minnesota that the City's staff shall take such action as is necessary to cause the County Auditor of Hennepin County to decertify District No. 1-6 as a tax increment district and to no longer remit tax increment from District No. 1-6 to the Authority.
