**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING JEFFREY WIKMAN TO THE POSITION OF
PUBLIC WORKS MAINTENANCE WORKER I**

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously established the position of full-time Public Works Maintenance Worker I; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Lake has advertised, solicited applications and interviewed a finalist for the position; and

WHEREAS, following a review of his employment application and in person interviews, City staff found Jeffrey Wikman to be qualified to fill the position based on his knowledge, skills, abilities and experience; and

WHEREAS, a successful pre-employment background check of Mr. Wikman has been performed by the Wayzata Police Department, reference checks have been completed by City staff, and a conditional offer of employment has been extended to and accepted by Mr. Wikman contingent upon approval by the Long Lake City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Long Lake, Minnesota does hereby appoint Jeffrey Wikman to the position of full-time Public Works Maintenance Worker I subject to the terms and conditions of the employment offer letter dated March 18, 2026, all applicable City personnel policies, and displaying an ability to continually meet the requirements of the position description. As indicated in his signed offer letter, Mr. Wikman will begin his employment on April 8, 2026.
