**A RESOLUTION APPOINTING JASON KIEPER TO THE POSITION OF  
PUBLIC WORKS MAINTENANCE WORKER I**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has previously established the position of full-time Public Works Maintenance Worker I; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Long Lake has advertised, solicited applications and interviewed a finalist for the position; and

**WHEREAS**, upon completing a review of his employment application and in person interviews, City staff finds Jason Kieper to be qualified to fill the position based on his knowledge, skills, abilities and experience; and

**WHEREAS**, a conditional offer of employment has been extended to and accepted by Mr. Kieper contingent upon a successful background check as performed by the Wayzata Police Department, and upon approval by the Long Lake City Council.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Long Lake, Minnesota does hereby appoint Jason Kieper to the position of full-time Public Works Maintenance Worker I subject to the terms and conditions of the employment offer letter dated December 17, 2025, all applicable City personnel policies, displaying an ability to continually meet the requirements of the position description, and contingent upon receiving satisfactory background check results. As indicated in his signed offer letter, Mr. Kieper will begin his employment sometime between January 15 and (no later than) February 2, 2026.
