**A RESOLUTION APPROVING ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF THE
HIGHWAY 12 ACCESS GATE**

WHEREAS, in 2011, the State entered into Agreement #00352 with the City of Long Lake for the construction of an electronic gate between Trunk Highway No 12 (TH 12) and Wayzata Boulevard W which stipulated that the State of Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) would contribute 33% of the cost for the gate's installation, with the City to be responsible for future gate maintenance, repair and replacement of this gate; and

WHEREAS, the City recently informed MnDOT that the gate electronics have been critically damaged by a rodent infestation to the degree that the gate is no longer functional, and as this gate provides a trunk highway benefit to MnDOT, it was agreed that a one-time contribution of \$7,318 would be provided by MnDOT for their portion of the necessary repairs via execution of a Joint Powers Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Long Lake hereby approves entering into MnDOT Joint Powers Contract / Agreement No. 1062560 (the Agreement) with the State of Minnesota Department of Transportation to provide for the repair and replacement of the access gate from City property to Trunk Highway No. 12, the limits of which are defined in said Agreement.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is authorized to execute the Agreement and any amendments to the Agreement.
