**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT #S2026-05
FOR THE CINCO DE MAYO BLOCK PARTY**

WHEREAS, the City has received a Special Event Permit application from Julie Schottler, owner of the Shiverz ice cream shop, to host a Cinco de Mayo Block Party event at the multi-tenant property located at 2435 Wayzata Boulevard W; and

WHEREAS, the event is proposed to consist of a food/taco truck operated by the Talavera Mexican Restaurant being on-site, ice cream and refreshments by Shiverz, lawn games available for attendees to play, a face painter for kids during the day, and broadcasting music outside; and

WHEREAS, the tenants in the multi-tenant building have been notified of the event, and the property owner has given authorization for the block party to proceed; and

WHEREAS, City staff and the Wayzata Police Department have reviewed the event application and identified conditions to permit issuance outlined on the Special Event Permit attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Long Lake hereby approves issuance of Special Event Permit #S2026-05 for the Cinco de Mayo Block Party to be held Saturday, May 2, 2026 contingent on receipt of documentation, agency approvals, and satisfaction of all applicable conditions outlined by the Special Event Permit.
