Staff recommends the following:

Motion to adopt Resolution No. 2026-37 recognizing September 17 to 23, 2026 as Constitution Week in the City of Long Lake.

Overview / Background

Mayor Miner received a request from Maureen Steele Bellows, Chair of the Constitution Week Committee of the Lake Minnetonka Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, asking that the City of Long Lake consider formally recognizing September 17 through 23, 2026 as Constitution Week. In 1955, the Daughters of the American Revolution petitioned Congress to set aside September 17 through 23 annually to be dedicated for the observance of Constitution Week. A resolution was later adopted by the US Congress and signed into Public Law #915 on August 2, 1956 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower. The aims of this commemoration are to emphasize citizens' responsibilities for protecting and preserving the Constitution; to recognize that the Constitution is the basis for America's heritage and the foundation for our way of life; and to encourage the study of the historical events which led to the framing of the Constitution in September 1787.

Staff has prepared the attached resolution to recognize September 17 to 23, 2026 as Constitution Week in the City of Long Lake. A certified copy of the signed resolution will be forwarded to Ms. Bellows following Council adoption.
