**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A WAGE STEP INCREASE FOR  
PUBLIC WORKS MAINTENANCE WORKER I MATT FAHRMAN**

**WHEREAS**, Public Works Maintenance Worker I Matt Fahrman received a satisfactory job performance review in conjunction with his six-month performance review and is eligible for a scheduled wage step increase; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Fahrman was appointed by City Council to the position of Public Works Maintenance Worker I on July 16, 2024 at the Step 1 wage rate for his position, and began his employment with the City on July 17, 2024.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Long Lake, Minnesota that the wage for Public Works Maintenance Worker I Matt Fahrman is hereby increased from Step 1 to Step 2 of the Salary Pay Plan effective January 17, 2025.
