Summary/Project Description:

On July 10, 2018, the City Council approved creation of the Public Art Fund. These funds are provided by commercial, mixed-use, and multi-family housing development projects. Developments pay 1% of construction costs towards the fund. These funds may be used for the acquisition, placement, maintenance, and promotion of public art and public art programs throughout the City.

Discussion/Analysis

As of July 1, 2022, the City had \$498,290 in the Public Art Fund. The City appropriated \$130,000 to the Annual Public Art Project in the CIP.
