




#### WHY:


- Provides the foundation for developing design solutions that not only solve the operational / use needs shared by Community and Staff, but...
- Also targets key functional and building system upgrades that can be done in tandem and in coordination with overall improvements.





Over representation of older demographic

Some families with children did participate

**3.2** Key Findings - Who Did We Hear From?



"Addressing the bigger question of how library use is actually changing. I.e. More public study/wave space vs. books/resource storage."

"Love this idea for picking up holds especially early mornings after I drop kids off at school."

- Community Member

Staff is more wary of change and have a more traditional opinion of how a library should function. The public is looking for modernization and thinking of how libraries function now and into the future

Improve the FOL space

Opinions were mixed about the value of after hours access with confusion between the "limited" and "full" options

> "Extended hours access is a vital use of the library. To me, it becomes an equity issue as underserved communities may have jobs or childcare issues and can only access library services during off hours. Access to holds, computers, meeting rooms, and pods is critical. Any reconfiguration that enables such use has my vote."

> "I support building quiet spaces – away from noisy children's area"



	Improve Friends' sales space	FOL desire more space for work area and sales, but need to balance with other library services.

	Address any accessibility concerns as discovered	Still relevant.

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




#### Anything will be a Reallocation of space










