The Los Altos Affordable Housing Alliance is delighted to see 5150 El Camino going forward again. We particularly like that the main buildings will now be rentals, as we believe the City needs more rental housing.

We commend staff for prudently protecting the city's affordable housing inventory in the unlikely case that the townhouses are built but the apartment construction is delayed.

As these buildings have already been approved once, and as the technical details of the inclusionary zoning and the separation of the townhouse portion of the project from the apartment portion have now been dealt with, we see no reason for this project to be further delayed, and we urge its speedy approval.
