The Commission, established by the City in 2011, is comprised of volunteer community artists and art lovers.

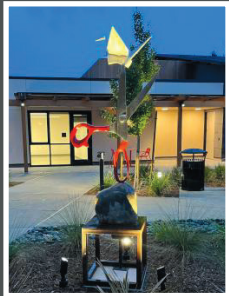
The Commission also sponsors City-wide activities including:

ART WITHOUT WALLS

Art Without Walls has been a key part of the City's Public Arts Program since the mid 1980's. Many sculptures that now comprise the City's permanent collection were once part of the Art Without Walls.

Artwork is loaned to the City for a two year period, after which its loan can either be extended for an additional two years or it can be returned to the artist. On occasion, artwork is either donated to the City by the artist, purchased by a third party as a gift to the City, or purchased by the City.



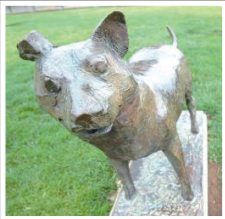

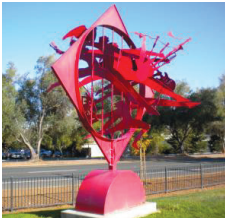

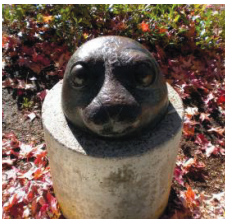

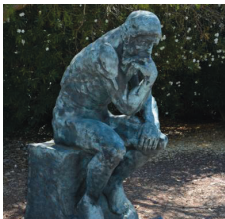
