Environmental

The Youth Commission's Environmental Subcommittee focuses on increasing awareness on issues related to the environment. This includes hosting events, publicizing information, and educating the community on the importance of environmental sustainability.

- Hosting a plant/succulent potting social
- Publicizing an Environmental Resource Guide focused on Env. Sustainability
- A seed bomb event with seeds from local nursery, would need \$100 budget
- Stand/Presence at June 16, 2022 Farmers Market
 - Will secure a second date at the Farmers Market to do 2 events

- Planning and running another movie night with Los Altos Hills on the evening of August 5th, 2022
