I understand you are the Project Planner for 707 Benvenue. First let me say, we are excited to welcome new neighbors on Benvenue. The cul-de-sac on our street is a special place. Children are often learning how to ride bikes, practicing jumps on ramps, shooting hoops, skateboarding and playing in our beloved Benvenue cul-de-sac. It is also the gathering location for our block party socials.

I am unable to attend the meeting today, however as a resident near the cul-de-sac, would kindly ask that the project and construction teams be mindful of cleaning up the sharp objects (nails, broken glass, wood, sharp metals, exacto blades, etc.) that are often unintentionally left as debris on construction sites, or in this case, in the cul-de-sac where many of our neighborhood kids play.

Many of the neighborhood children use the cul-de-sac as a place afterschool to gather and to play. My worry is that the cul-de-sac becomes a "parking lot" for construction teams and that our neighborhood children are left without their local gathering / play space. It would be great if the construction crew could be mindful to leave the cut-thru path and the basketball hoop area accessible and a safe place for kids to gather and utilize.

Lastly, it would be great if you could remind the on-going construction teams to mind their speed on our street, especially at the "horseshoe" portion of our street. We have witnessed too many "near misses" and hope to keep everyone safe. We look forward to welcoming our new neighbors when the project is complete.
