- Gathering information as needed for the Los Fresnos 20-Year Comprehensive Plan.
- Discussions held with the Cameron County Economic Department to explore any strategies they
 may have for the Los Fresnos ETJ.
- The Workforce Solutions Cameron provided a Los Fresnos economic profile and copy emailed to the board members.

- ❖ Gathering information from Amigos del Valle and RGV Area Agency on Aging on services available at the Los Fresnos Community Center. For example, the Area Agency on Aging has \$5,000 grants for elderly and the USDA has \$10,000 grants for persons 62 years and older to do home repairs. Question is, "How can the LFCDC reach out to more folks to receive these home repair grants?" Working on a strategy to present to the city manager and board in December. Pending a visit with Amigos del Valle.
