SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Subdivision, Article III, Minimum Standards and Specifications, in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Los Fresnos, Texas is hereby amended to reflect as follows:

Sec. 38-79 Sewers, (j) *Manholes*. Manholes shall be fiberglass with a cast iron ring and cover SuperCover Composite Manhole Cover and Ring or comparable as approved by the City. There shall be a manhole approximately every 400 feet or less, and at strategic locations and when the sewer line changes direction more than 20 degrees.

Sec. 38-80 Utility lines, All utility lines that are underground and run under a street or alley shall be installed by the developer and approved by the city before the street or alley is paved. When it is necessary that utility lines pass under the street or alley pavement crossing the centerline, they shall be installed to a point of at least three feet beyond the edge of the pavement. Water lines, main or lateral may not be encased unless meeting TCEQ separation requirements. Main or lateral water lines are not required to be encased unless specifically required by the City, TCEQ, TXDOT or other relevant entity. All underground utilities installed in a utility easement at the rear of the lot shall be offset from the property line.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances that are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part of provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect after the final reading and when caption of Ordinance has been published in the official newspaper of the City.
