Update needed to render

“content-neutral”

“Temporary Sign” Regulations



Temporary Signs

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Goal: Adopt “time, place, and manner” regulations that can be applied to temporary signs without regard to content:

Location

Distance Between Signs

Duration of Display

Size and Height

Regulations



Location

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- 1)** Should all temporary signs in the public right-of-way be prohibited?
 - a.** Prohibited only in median and on sidewalks?
 - b.** Permitted in any grassy areas in front of or beyond the sidewalk?

“Temporary Sign” Regulations



Distance

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- 2)** Should there be a distance requirement between temporary signs in the public right-of-way?
- a.** For example, some require at least 50-foot distance between temporary signs
 - b.** Allow one temporary sign at each corner of an intersection on weekends

Duration of Display

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- 3) Should there be a limited duration for the display of temporary signs?

Size (Public Right-of-Way)

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- 4) What should the size limit be for temporary signs that are allowed in the public right-of-way?
 - a. For example, some limit to a maximum of six square feet and 3 feet in height

Size (Private Property)

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- 5) What should the size limit be for temporary signs that are allowed on private property?
