

Purpose

- To objectively assess Town programs and services
- To gather input from residents to help Town leaders set priorities
- To identify areas of improvement for the community

Methodology

- Administered by mail, phone, and online with follow-ups by text, email, and social media to the random sample of residential addresses.
- Sample designed to ensure results are statistically valid and representative
- 502 completed surveys were collected, MOE: +/-4.34% at 95% level of confidence
 - Goal was 400.


Priorities for Improvement

The instrument was designed so ETC Institute could develop priorities for improvement. Flow of traffic on Town streets was a highlighted area for improvement.

Distribution of Responses

ensure all areas of the Town are equally represented. Throughout the survey administration process, ETC Institute monitors response distribution to maintain geographic balance.

Responses have been coded to the block level to maintain respondent anonymity.


Los Gatos received ratings above 50% in all areas assessed.







by percentage of respondents (excluding don't know)






Perceptions: Benchmarking


More than half of respondents were satisfied in 5/7 areas assessed.

by percentage of respondents (excluding don't know)






Major Town Services: Importance


Major Town Services: Benchmarking

Los Gatos is above the Regional and National averages in all areas assessed.

Town Police Services saw the biggest gain since 2022. All other areas remained consistent with 2022 scores.


Los Gatos received ratings above 50% in all areas assessed.

by percentage of respondents (excluding don't know)





Los Gatos vs. California Average vs. 30-99k Pop. Average vs. National Average






Public Safety: Trends


Streets, Sidewalks, and Infrastructure






Streets, Sidewalks, and Infrastructure: **Importance**




Streets, Sidewalks, and Infrastructure: Trends


Community Investment Areas

by percentage of respondents (excluding don't know)






Community Investment Areas: **Importance**





Community Investment Areas: Trends

Most of the items have remained consistent with 2022 scores. Only three areas saw notable decreases in support since 2022:
