SUBJECT: Adopt Ordinance 2339 Titled "An Ordinance of the Town Council of the Town of Los Gatos Amending Chapter 3, "Amusements," of the Town Code Regarding Bingo Award Amount Amending Section 3.50.015 of the Town Code to Increase the Maximum Bingo Award to \$500"

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Ordinance 2339 titled "An Ordinance of the Town Council of the Town of Los Gatos Amending Chapter 3, "Amusements," of the Town Code regarding bingo award amount Amending Section 3.50.015 of the Town Code to increase the maximum bingo award to \$500."

BACKGROUND:

At its regular meeting of March 21, 2023, the Town Council held a public hearing to consider the introduction of Ordinance 2339 to amend Chapter 3, of the Town Code "Amusements," regarding bingo award amount amending Section 3.50.015 to increase the maximum bingo award to \$500. The Town Council voted 5-0 to approve the introduction of Ordinance 2239. This ordinance will become effective 30 days after adoption.

CONCLUSION:

Staff recommends the Town Council adopt Ordinance 2339 titled "An Ordinance of the Town Council of the Town of Los Gatos Amending Chapter 3, "Amusements," of the Town Code regarding bingo award amount amending Section 3.50.015 of the Town Code to increase the maximum bingo award to \$500."
