SUBJECT: **Study Session Regarding State Route 17 Corridor Congestion Relief Project**

RECOMMENDATION: Receive a presentation from Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority staff regarding the State Route 17 Corridor Congestion Relief Project

REMARKS:

Staff from the Department of Parks and Public Works has been working with Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA), California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and their consultant team to support development of the State Route 17 Corridor Congestion Relief Project (CIP No. 8142; Legacy Project Number 831-0237). The purpose of the project is to relieve congestion and improve traffic flow on State Route 17 (SR17), reduce cut through traffic in the Town of Los Gatos, improve bicycle and pedestrian facilities and connectivity between east and west sides of SR 17, and support future multi-modal congestion relief solutions.

At this meeting, VTA staff will present an overview of the project design and how the project will improve local conditions in Town and along SR 17.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

This Project is being reviewed under both CEQA and NEPA statutory requirements and a Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment is being finalized for public circulation and public comment.
