Hello Sean,

Two more minor corrections:

- 1. Existing Exterior Materials: Further investigation for the construction documents has found that some of the existing materials were substituted during construction from those of the 2015 permit drawings used for our submittal. A corrected Existing Materials chart is attached. This does not change the existing look nor our submitted proposed materials. The only correction of significance is the existing sash (S03) is White not Dark Bronze. White on this sash is only seen around the perimeter and inside the showroom as the glass is butt-glazed with black sealant outside. This can be seen clearly in your report Exhibit 7, pages 74 + 75.
- 2. Two New Showrooms: Exhibit 6 "Evolution:" written over a year ago calls out "Four new boutique showrooms", we have further evolved to two now with the current design.


