We would like to clarify that while we have provided outreach information for all neighbors listed in the Town's First Comment Letter, one of the 14 names included was our own (Deepak Gupta and Carolyn Nguyen, 16717 Chirco Drive). As such, we have included our information in the response table for completeness and consistency with the Town's list. This means we were only provided contact details for 13 unique neighboring households. We want to ensure there is no misunderstanding — we have engaged all of the other neighbors listed and did not intentionally omit any outreach.
