Current Policies

<u>RVs</u>

Permit required. \$50 + \$400 (solid waste assessment, 50% refundable)
1 RV on lots 1-2 acres.
2 RVs on lots 2-10 acres.
No more than 4 RVs on lots more than 10 acres.
Permits valid for 179 days.

Groom's Quarters

Permitted on properties with equestrian uses and 6 or more stalls. Accessory Use.

Caretakers Quarters

Permitted on bona fide agriculture properties. Accessory Use.

Current Town Challenges
