<b>Summary Statement:</b>	<p>U.S. Cities are required by the Environmental Protection Agency to inventory drinking water distribution systems for the occurrence of lead and copper. Though the City of Lynden has no known lead pipes, Public Works is compelled to inspect a subset of service lines by October 2024 to confirm this.</p> <p>Affected households are those constructed before 1989. Owners will be randomly selected and contacted via mail to voluntarily submit information on their homes' water pipes. Informational materials are available on the City website.</p>
