| <p>Staff would like Council to consider a short-term lease with "Let's Pool Together" which is an affiliate of the Bellingham Bay Swim Club.</p> <p>In brief; the lease agreement would give the Club access to the pool in the Lynden Recreation Center in exchange for providing public access. In the beginning this access would be limited to water aerobics on weekdays only. If there is sufficient demand, pool hours could be expanded and include other uses, such as lap and recreational swimming.</p> <p>To accomplish this, the Swim Club would provide the staff to run the programs, insurance and water testing. It would also be responsible for ensuring all activities comply with Phase 2 COVID restrictions.</p> |   |   |
