<b>Summary Statement:</b>	<p>Corwin McCaig resigned from the Airport Advisory Board in May 2024. Greg Bell has submitted a letter of interest in serving on the board for the remainder of the term through December 31, 2025.</p> <p>According to Lynden Municipal Code Chapter 2.54.010, vacancies on the board shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of City Council, and appointees shall serve the unexpired term to which they are appointed. The Airport Board members operate in an advisory capacity to the Lynden City Council to make recommendations concerning the adoption of rules, regulations or policies for the management, operation and use of the airport, and the highways, roads, streets and territories adjacent to the airport.</p> <p>The Airport Advisory Board met on June 28, 2024, and supports the appointment of Bell. The Mayor and Public Works Committee reviewed Bell’s request for appointment at their July 1, 2024, meeting and concurred to forward Bell’s appointment to City Council for approval.</p>	
<b>Recommended Action:</b>	That City Council confirm the Mayor’s appointment of Greg Bell to the Lynden Municipal Airport Advisory Board for the remainder of the vacated term ending December 31, 2025.
