<b>Summary Statement:</b>	<p>Staff has applied for and received Department of Ecology approval for a Stormwater Financial Assistance Program Grant and Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan to construct stormwater improvements on 8<sup>th</sup> Street from Judson Street to Front Street and the adjacent midblock east-west alleys. This is the first phase of planned street and stormwater improvements in the Judson area bounded by 7<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Streets on the east and west, and Front Street to the north. Included in this funding package is a grant in the amount of \$644,959.00 and a loan in the amount of \$214,986.33 with terms of 20 years and a 1.2% interest rate plus 0.3% administrative charge. Staff is planning to use TBD funds for repayment of the loan and provide sewer and water funds for needed utility upgrades under the streets.</p> <p>This was discussed at the November 3, 2021, Public Works Committee meeting.</p>	
<b>Recommended Action:</b>	<p>That City Council approve Resolution No. 1041 Approving City Use of Stormwater Financial Assistance Program Grant and Clean Water State Revolving Fund Loan for Judson Area Stormwater Low Impact Development– Phase 1 and authorize the Mayor’s signature on the applicable agreement with the Department of Ecology.</p>
