| The Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) was signed into law on March 18, 2020 and took effect on April 1, 2020. The FFCRA provides two categories of leave. The first expands existing FMLA coverage to provide up to 12 weeks of partially-paid Public Health Emergency Leave for eligible employees forced to miss work due to closure of their child's school or the unavailability of the child's childcare provider for reasons related to COVID-19. | | |
| The second provides up to 10 days of Emergency Paid Sick Leave for various reasons related to the COVID-19 outbreak. The attached policy provides information and guidance on administration of these two leaves. | | |
