| The City is required to develop a Stormwater Management Action Plan as a requirement of the City's Stormwater National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit with the State Department of Ecology. The area of the City was divided into discrete stormwater basins following establish policy, and the basins were ranked based on criteria including opportunity for improvement. The Central District Basin has been identified as an area with the most needed improvements. Within that basin the City identifies the work that has been done in the recent past and identified both short- and long-term future projects that would be accomplished to improve water quality. There are three Judson Area Stormwater Low Impact Design projects (8th, 9th, 10th and Judson Streets) that have either received or are likely to receive grant funding for construction in this basin. In response to feedback from the public and from staff, additions, deletions and/or clarifications have been incorporated into the Stormwater Management Action Plan. The Public Works Committee reviewed the draft Stormwater Management Action Plan at their meeting on March 8, 2023, and City Council set this Public Hearing at their March 20, 2023 meeting. | | |
