Summary Statement:		
The City of Lynden is considering a modification to the vacation of the right-of-way easement for the extension of 17 th Street resulting from the Settlement between Marina Timmermans and the City of Lynden. This settlement agreement was originally executed in October of 2013. An alteration to the settlement is now being considered to shift the proposed right-of-way approximately 8-foot to the west, to the benefit of the property owner, to create a larger and more developable portion of property east of the proposed street.		

As such, the owner of the property underlying the proposed vacated easement and the City have agreed to exchange the vacated easement for a similar easement of equal value located slightly west of the easement being vacated.

A public hearing on this issue was held before the City Council on July 17, 2019.

Recommended Action:

Motion to approve Ordinance 1587 vacating a portion of Right-of-Way and approving the corresponding agreement for a Right of Way Grant from Marina A Timmermans, the underlying property owner to facilitate the 17th Street Extension Project and authorizing the Mayor's signature on the documents.
