## Illuminated Signs.

## Existing:

All Signs may be illuminated by indirect, or internal lighting methods. For those Signs that are illuminated by an internal lighting source, it is encouraged that the Sign Face be opaque and only the copy and logos illuminate.

## **Proposed Revision:**

Signs may be illuminated by indirect, internal or exposed lighting methods.

- 1. For signs using indirect lighting, such lighting shall be directed or minimized to reduce glare to adjoining properties or the right-of-way.
- 2. For those signs that are illuminated by an internal lighting source, it is encouraged that the Sign Face be opaque and only the copy and logos illuminate.
- For signs using an exposed lighting method, such method must be incorporated as part of a sign or sign face. Signs constructed solely of exposed neon material is not permitted.
- 4. Illuminated signs may not flash, rotate or blink. See Prohibited Signs, LMC 19.33.035.
