Let's Pool Together provides:

- 1. Insurance to cover BBST and Community.
- 2. Lifeguards for Community swim times.
- 3. Lifeguard staff to greet and check in the Community (during Community hours).
- 4. Individual to check water daily and ensure it remains properly chlorinated.
- 5. Mechanism for signing up community members, either online or in person.
- 6. Security to open and close the facility.
- 7. Ensure the facility is operated in compliance with state COVID guidelines.

City provides:

- 1. Custodial
- 2. All expenses associated with operating the facility, including utilities (heat and light).
- 3. Aerobics instructors (City may want to pay for the instructors but have them employed by the Swim Club).
- 4. Cost of operation beyond initial \$5,000 per month, estimated to be approximately \$6,000 per month, up to total of \$11,000 per month in operation costs.

Miscellaneous

- 1. Community users would sign up for 50 -minute time slots on-line for both lap swims and aquarobics. There will be a 10-minute buffer between swim times to allow for distancing and sanitation. Club looking into software.
- 2. Users would be limited to using restrooms but no lockers or showers (need clarification here).

3.	Either party can terminate the agreement for any reason after 10 business days of giving notice.
