3. Chief Noonan provide the Monthly report for the Fire Department for December. There were 209 total calls, 72 of which were overlapping. Ten fire prevention/inspections were performed throughout the City as well as two Community Outreach days, where car seat inspections were performed.

A request was put forward for the surplus of the 2010 eFord 450 reserve ambulance (A7503). The approximate salvage value would be \$13,333.33

### **Police Department Items**

4. Public Safety Stats - November 2024. Chief Taylor advised that Domestic Violence and Theft calls were up for December. Overall, total calls were up by 188 since November.

Chief Taylor also provided the 2024 stats for the Records Department. Among these stats, the Department received 574 records requests up from 472 in 2023. Body Worn Camera requests are up as well, and it was explained how labor/time extensive they are.
