<p>The Lynden Regional Park and Recreation District has assisted the City in a number of park projects over the last number of years.</p> <p>The district is desirous to again assist the City in expanding its trail system, beginning to develop park properties and with the acquisition of park properties.</p> <p>The District is proposing Proposition 2019-4 to the voters on the general election to be held on Nov. 5, requesting approval of a \$3 million dollar bond to extend the trail system through the Dickinson property, begin the utilities, roads and restrooms needed to make Benson Park usable, and to assist with the acquisition of the Glenning Street property.</p> <p>Parks Committee reviewed Resolution No. 1009 and recommends forwarding the resolution to full council for their approval of support for the Rec.
