<b><u>Summary Statement</u></b>		
<p>The Council is being asked to consider and confirm the Mayor's appointment of Steve Jilk to the City's Planning Commission for a four-year term.</p> <p>Mr. Jilk has expressed an interest in serving the community by taking a seat on the Planning Commission. Steve has been involved in many different aspects of the Lynden Community for over 30 years, including the former City of Lynden Administrator, School Board Member, Director of the Economic Development and Marine Services for the Port of Bellingham, as well as the General Manager of Whatcom County PUD #1.</p> <p>Jilk would be filling a Planning Commission seat that has been vacant for some time. The Mayor has appointed Seve to a four-year term beginning in June 2025 and ending at the close of December 2029 and asks that the Council confirm this appointment.</p>
