<b>Summary Statement:</b>		
<p>The City of Lynden's ADA Transition Plan for Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way, or accessible to the general public via easements, includes the following required elements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Identify physical obstacles in the facilities that limit the accessibility of its programs or activities to individuals with disabilities.</li><li>2. Describe in detail the methods that will be used to make the facilities accessible.</li><li>3. Specify the schedule for taking the steps necessary to achieve compliance and if the duration of the transition plan is longer than one year, identify steps that will be taken each year.</li><li>4. Indicate the official responsible for implementation of the plan.</li></ol> <p>The Public Works Committee reviewed the Draft ADA Transition Plan at their meeting on November 6, 2024, and recommended forwarding to City Council for consideration.</p>		
<b>Recommended Action:</b>		
That City Council, after hearing public comments, approve and authorize the Mayor's signature on Resolution No. 24-1112 adopting the ADA Transition Plan.
