Summary Statement:		
Staff recently solicited bids for the Industrial Condensate Pipeline Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) project. Three		
bids were received on November 10, 2020. Reichhardt and Ebe Engineering prepared the attached Bid		
Tabulation.		
The Public Works Committee at their November 4 th meeting concurred that the bid results could be		
forwarded directly to City Council after informing them of the results. The Committee was advised of the bids		
and concurred to recommend award to Michels Corporation, the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in		
the amount of \$107,169.50, including Washington State Sales Tax. This project will be funded in part with		
Department of Commerce funds. The balance of the funding will be from Water Utility Capital (Fund 401).		
Recommended Action:		
That City Council award the contract for the Industrial Condensate Pipeline Cured in Place Pipe project to		
Michels Corporation in the amount of \$107,169.50, including Washington State Sales Tax, and authorize the		
Mayor to sign the contract.
