<b>Summary Statement:</b>	<p>The City of Lynden has developed an updated Comprehensive Stormwater Plan referenced in the City's overall Comprehensive Plan (Chapter 5, Section 5.2.3), as required under the State's Growth Management Act. Additionally, this plan was revised to meet the terms of the City's Western Washington Phase II National Pollutant Discharge Elimination (NPDES) Permit.</p> <p>The Comprehensive Stormwater Management Plan offers guidance on ways to minimize the adverse effects of stormwater runoff to receiving water bodies and identifies existing stormwater issues within the system. The Plan provides City staff and policy makers with the background and necessary information to develop and manage the storm drainage system in a cost-effective manner that complies with regulatory stipulations. The objectives are to understand the current conveyance and water quality treatment issues to position the City for effective planning of future improvements. As such, this plan functions as a long-term planning tool that prepares the City for population growth over a 20-year horizon. The Plan outlines methods for meeting regulatory requirements and developing policies and procedures; and defines capital facilities projects for the Stormwater Utility.</p> <p>The full document is available upon request and will be posted to the City's website.</p> <p>At their December 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, the Public Works Committee concurred to recommend a public hearing date of January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to hear comments on the City's Stormwater Comprehensive Plan.</p>
