Trends continue to show an upward climb, closing out May with 212 calls. This seems to now be the monthly normal. 86% of our call volume is dedicated to providing Emergency Medical Services, which are also the most time consuming calls outside of a working structure fire. We are also facing instances of multiple calls in progress, leaving the city without available LFD responders for significant stretches of time as call volume continues to increase.
