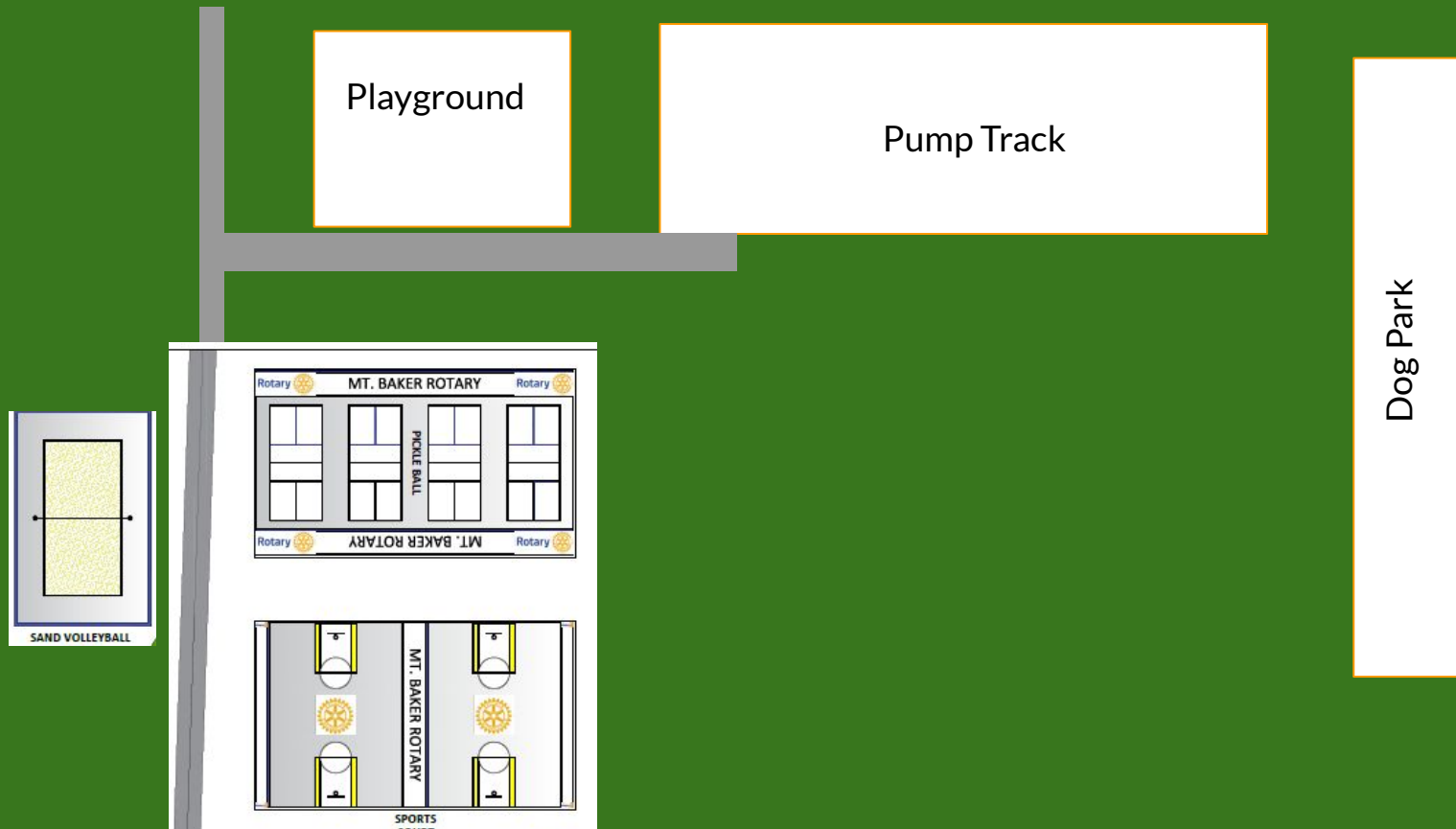


Lynden Pump Track at Bender Fields: **Current Status**

- Approval of concept from Lynden Parks Committee
- Concept for the site
- Agreement with Mt. Baker Rotary for location

- Step 1 Construction Begins July 16

Lynden Pump Track at Bender Fields: **Step 1**

- Revised plan to adapt to current fundraising environment (COVID-19)
- Pivoted from Asphalt Track to Dirt Track
- Pivoted from National Building to Local Builder
- Fundraising in place for Step 1 construction





Lynden Pump Track at Bender Fields: **Benefits of Two Steps**

- Allows the project to utilize local resources
- Allows community to experience a track and provide feedback
- Allows the team to learn what works and what doesn't prior to completing the final track design
- Allows time to fundraise additional funds while still delivering on our commitment to the community
