- 3. Projecting Signs that project into the right-of-way shall comply with the requirements of LMC 19.23.070.
- 4. Projecting Signs shall have a minimum clearance of eight (8) feet above the sidewalk and six (6) inches from the vertical wall.
- 5. Each Main Entry shall have no more than one (1) Projecting Sign.
- H. Reader Board Signs (Including Electronic Reader Board Signs).
 - 1. Applicability.
 - <u>.a.</u>Reader Board Signs are permitted within the CSL, CSR, and PU zones.
 - b.__New Reader Board Signs are prohibited within the HBD_zone.
 - a.c. In the , RS, RM, and ID/IBZ zones Reader Board Signs are permitted as a Conditional Use. Review of a Conditional Use request must consider the impacts of an electronic reader board sign at the location and may be approved with conditions which limit the size, brightness, and duration of display to be more restrictive than those standards described in this section. Exception: Reader Board Signs located within the RS and RM zones may be allowed pursuant to a permitted Conditional Use Permit.
 - d. Reader Board Signs located within the RS and RM zones are only allowed in association with a use that is permitted through a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) such as an educational or religious facility and may be approved with conditions which limit the size, brightness, and duration of display.
 - 2. Sign Area. A Reader Board Sign located within a RM or RS zone permitted through in association with a conditional use permit shall not exceed sixteen (16) square feet in Sign Area. Exception: if the Reader Board Sign is incorporated into a larger Sign Structure, then the total Sign Area shall not exceed forty (40) square feet. A Reader Board Sign located within an HBD, CSL, or PU zone or as a Conditional Use in a IBZ/ID zone shall not exceed thirty (30) square feet in Sign Area. In the CSR zone, a Reader Board Sign shall not exceed thirty-six (36) square feet or seventy-five percent (75%) of a lot's total allowable Sign Area, whichever is less.
 - 3. New Portable Reader Board Signs. No new portable Reader Board Signs shall be installed after the adoption of this code provision.

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
